QUESTION 1 You have put on a lot of weight since last year. Can you still fit into your old clothes?

QUESTION 2 No sooner has he learned something than he forgets it. Do you think he has a good memory?

4. Yes, I think he has good memories of his mother.

QUESTION 3 Your friend promises to lend you a novel by your favorite writer after he is through with it. When will you get it?

4. When he has finished reading the novel

QUESTION 4 The harbormaster's office has received a call from a ship which has run aground near the port and is asking for assistance. Which of the following would be a suitable response?

2. "I will send tugs to help you off the rocks as soon as possible."
3. "I advise you to let your passengers disembark on the long pier."

QUESTION 5 You are the captain of a ship and about to berth at the designated point. What do you order the deck crew to do with the anchors?
